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# Importance of Education in Culture


There is the close relationship between education and culture. Both are dependent on each other.

1. Influence of culture on education. Culture can influence on following aspects of education:
  - a. **On aims of education:** The cultural ideas, values and patterns of the society determines the aims of education.

  - g. **On School**: According to pragmatic philosophy, school is a miniature society where the cultural ideals and values are reflected .
